**Audience:** 30-100 students (mainly undergraduate level) from BUEB, with a possibility of opening the course for students from partner universities.

**Assessment:** to be included in the 5 days of the course. The assessment instrument must be summative, can include a group component, as well as a digital element (e.g. video presentation recorded by the participating students).

- International Business
- Management
- Marketing

# Deliver a Short Course in Business Studies in 5 Days in Person in Budapest

### **Eligibility:**

- The applicant must be a current faculty member of a European higher education institution (preferably with a high QS/THE ranking in the respective discipline).
- The applicant must propose a detailed course outline, including objectives, syllabus, teaching methodology, and assessment criteria. The course should be designed to be engaging and provide valuable insights into the selected area of business studies.
- The proposed course must be structured to fit within the five-day time frame, including a suitable balance between lectures, discussions, and assessment.

### **Application Requirements:**

- A curriculum vitae (CV) of the applicant with proof of current affiliation with a European university (e.g. link to the personal page on the institutional website).
- Course proposal, including title of the course, learning objectives, syllabus (including daily breakdown), proposed teaching methods (lectures, case studies, discussions, group work, etc.) and assessment details.
- A short statement outlining why the applicant is interested in exploring academic cooperation with BUEB.

#### **Benefits:**

- An honorarium of **2,500 EUR** for the course delivery (the applicant is expected to arrange own transportation, accommodation and meals). Continuous support by a BUEB faculty member.
- Optional cooperation with a relevant Hungarian company (with a corporate guest lecture and/or a study visit).
- Business lunch with a BUEB faculty member from the respective academic area to discuss further academic cooperation (e.g. joint research).
- Access to university facilities, including classrooms and technology support.
